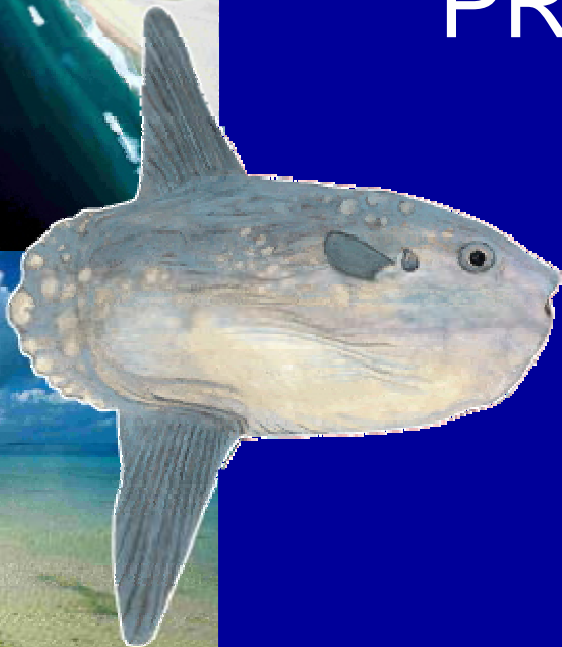


## UPDATE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO PROJECT OUTPUTS AND ACTIVITIES



## NEW OR AMENDED ACTIVITIES

### Near-shore Artisanal/Subsistence Fisheries Data Collection:

Focusing on capture of Hard-Copy Fisheries Data; In-field nearshore Fish Species Collections

Critical Habitats and Species Data Collection: including Pre-Survey Desk-Top Study; Shore-Based Surveys for Validation;

Invasive Species and Marine Pollutants Data Collection: Including support for national specialists and data monitoring programmes

## NEW OR AMENDED ACTIVITIES (continued)

Coastal Livelihoods Data Collection: With support for national specialists

Ecosystem Approach Cost-Benefit Analysis: Including support for national working groups

Marine Ecosystem Governance Data Capture: Including support for national working groups

## NEW OR AMENDED ACTIVITIES

GIS and Predictive Modelling: Including support for country specialists and national level spatial digitising of new data

Remote Sensing and Multidimensional Mapping: Including support for country specialists and national level imagery acquisition and manipulation

Adoption of Common Fisheries MC&S and Reporting Practices (for nearshore artisanal community fishing): With support for national MCS specialists, workshops and equipment as well as Project assistance to access additional funding sources

## NEW OR AMENDED ACTIVITIES

National MEDA Production: Project to provide national MEDA production and support costs to countries

Political Sustainability: Including national policy level briefings (preparation and delivery); regional policy level round-tables; policy-level briefing films

## NEW OR AMENDED ACTIVITIES

Independent Output Evaluations: Independent peer-level reviews and evaluations of individual activities

On-Going Evaluation of Project: ‘Progress-chasing’ on Delivery and rolling review of Project Logical Framework

## These improvements will:

- Rationalise the project activities and deliverables in terms of the additional information requirements as agreed by GEF and the Steering Committee
- Update the Project outputs and activities in relation to further initiatives and activities since submission of the Project Document
- Provide an additional level of support to the countries for their national commitments to the Project, especially in terms of MEDA delivery

N.B. The revised outputs do not alter the objectives or expected deliveries from the Project but merely rationalise these deliveries in terms of timing and realistic support costs, notably by providing a higher level of support to the countries
